


### **Getting started**

- Engagingly written







### Writing style


- Short words
- Short sentences
- Short paragraphs
- No jargon
- No abbreviations
- Avoid figures of speech and idioms
- Prefer active to passive













### **Keywords**

- Keywords help people to find your paper.
- How to choose keywords:
- What keywords are used in related literature?
- General? Or specific?
- If you were searching for your paper on Google, what words would you use?



#### **Peer review recommendations**


- Publish as is
- Publish with minor amendments
- Publish with major amendments
- Reject



### **Responding to reviewers**

- Outrage, noise, unladylike rejoinders.
- Incomprehension.
- More outrage.
- One or two of these comments might make sense.
- There's a bit of truth in that one.
- I'll just have a go at doing what they said to do here.
- Actually the paper is a whole lot better for all of these revisions.
